MILLÉSIME

This very old vine (around 80 years old) is situated in south-west of the appellation, in one of the better climats of Rully,

"Grésigny" which would mean in Burgundian old language: "A rapid small hillside".

DÉGUSTATION

The nose shows flinty minerality which makes it shy on opening.

The aromas are fresh, rich, and ripe. They are reminiscent of acacia blossom, citrus fruits accompanied by a hint of oak which brings a touch almost stony, smoky from the limestone.

The palate is very elegant. You can see the fruit quality of these 80-year-old vines. Everything is in the fruit concentration giving the impression of power, depth throughout in the mouth. The finish remains as the other Rully 1er Crus, surprisingly long, fresh, and very saline with notes of bitter lemon.

The balance suggests waiting a little before enjoying it. Two or three years to discover it on the fruit and after five years to perceive the rather exceptional quality of this terroir.

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
